Ivan Uldrijan gained his first media experiences volunteering on "Radio Daruvar" in 1997. In 2003 he began to collaborate as a journalist with "Glas Koncila", in 2007 he became journalist-member of editorial board and in 2013 Secretary of the editorial staff of "Glas Koncila". As a journalist he also collaborated with the Children and Youth Programme of Croatian Television (2004-2005), Croatian Catholic Radio (2004), and occasionally with Informative Catholic Agency (IKA).

His texts have been published in books: "Kako u crkveni brak: vodič na putu prema sakramentu ženidbe" (Glas Koncila, 2011), "Zajedno u Kristu. Pohod pape Benedikta XVI. Hrvatskoj" (Croatian Bishops' Conference, Glas Koncila, 2012), and "Vjera naših dana: izazovi i ideje za produblјivanje vjere suvremenih ljudi" (Glas Koncila, 2014). He was the reviewer of the book "Bez razgovora se ne može. Kvalitetnijim razgovorom do sebe i drugih" from the author Pavao Brajša, published by "Glas Koncila" in 2013.
