Opis predmeta	<p>The aim of this course is to explain the trends of migration in the Mediterranean from the very beginning to recent times. Define the differences between migrant communities in the surveyed countries with regard to demographic indicators, development, time and manner of migration and determine knowledge through examples from practice and life. Define migration pull and push factors and use examples to highlight migrations caused by wars, political conflicts and border changes. Give a modern picture of migration in the Mediterranean and point out the problems that arise due to migration in receiving countries, such as demographic indicators, problems with migrant education, cultural habits, language barrier, etc., but also in the home countries of migrants. Point out the migration policy of some European countries towards migrants and the need to make it in the Republic of Croatia, especially now given the new situation in the region.</p>
